Mariachi Los Santos was founded in 2000 by Bill Hassing, the former band director at Santa Ana High School. His goal was to teach more cultural music to better serve the large Hispanic community. Students take mariachi as a credit towards graduation. Since the beginning of the class, the focus has been to expose students to their own cultural music heritage.

The group has performed for notable government officials such as the governors of California, Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Sonora, Chihuahua, Coahuila, and Nuevo León. This year we've accompanied Lupita Infante, famed actor/singer and Pedro Infante's granddaughter. In February, we'll be featuring with Steeven Sandoval, one of the greatest voices in modern mariachi singing.

Our ensemble is unique in that it is part of a large conservatory that has been formed at Santa Ana High School. The group has a history of excellence and has enjoyed performing at the Battle of the Mariachis in San Juan Capistrano. They have won the People's Choice Award 2 years sequentially.
