



Portrait Photography (engagement, wedding, family, graduation, maternity, quinceañera, etc.)

Fees and Requirements to reserve an Hourly Time Slot

- Reservations are required at least a week in advance. Due to high demand and limited time slots, we recommend booking more than one week in advance as the Mission limits photo sessions to four (4) per hour and treats all sessions as reservations for the specific time reserved.
- Full payment is required for all reservations at the time of booking. All payments are nonrefundable.
- Additional nonrefundable fees apply for Videographers and Photographers without Liability Insurance.

A regular non-commercial photography session is one hour for five (5) guests and two (2) photographers.

Reservation Rates for non-commercial photography
\$80 per hour for one (1) to five (5) guests.
\$160 per hour for six (6) to ten (10) guests.
\$240 per hour for eleven (11) to fifteen (15) guests.
\$320 per hour for sixteen (16) to twenty (20) guests.

Videography is not permitted with a portrait photography session. Videographers must

- Make a separate reservation and are required to have a current certificate of liability.
 - All equipment must be hand held and minimal. No tripods, microphones, boom pole or cables allowed.
- Photographers and Videographers must** obtain proof of \$1,000,000 (\$1 million) liability insurance policy.

Booking hours, fees and requirements are subject to change without notice.

Walk Up session are prohibited.

Please note the operation or use of any drones, unmanned aircraft/flying systems, and remotely-controlled or radio-controlled flying machines (whether or not motorized) of all types, shapes, and sizes at any time in the vicinity of or on Mission property is prohibited. No pets allowed.

The use of tripods, set pieces/props, additional lenses, and lighting equipment MUST be approved in advance by our Booking Coordinator.

Commercial Photography and Filming

- Applications for commercial photography or filming must be submitted at least two weeks in advance. Site fees vary based on the details of each project. Application and details can be found on our website <http://www.missionsjc.com/filming-photography/commercial-filming/>

Did you know? Mission San Juan Capistrano has a variety of Photography Members who receive a \$50 rate per hour for non-commercial photography (up to five guests being photographed).

Portrait Photography at Mission San Juan Capistrano

In order to ensure the enjoyment of our guests and safety of our grounds, The Mission has restricted the amount of photoshoots allowed per day. Portrait photography includes (but is not limited to):

- Family portraits
 - Engagements
 - Weddings
 - Quinceñera
 - Maternity
 - Graduation photos
 - Company Team photos
 - Christmas photos
- All photography with clients, professional or amateur, that utilize professional equipment or professional services (hair dresser, florist, make- up artist etc.) require a commercial reservation.
 - Photographs taken at the Mission may not be published, sold, reproduced, distributed or otherwise commercially exploited.
 - Guests & photographer are not permitted to climb on walls, arcades, ruins or historical structures.
 - Appropriate attire is required.
 - Clothes with obscene language / graphics, excessively torn clothes are not permitted.
 - Clothes exposing excessive portions of the skin, thigh-high hem level dresses, plunging necklines to the belly level / lower rib cage, sheer, lace and see through attire are not permitted.
 - The use of lighting, reflectors, props (flowers, umbrellas, tables, chairs etc.), change of clothes, and formal wear is considered by Mission San Juan Capistrano to be a commercial photography session.
 - Pets are not permitted on the Mission grounds.
 - There is no access to onsite electricity or power.
 - Additional guidelines and rules will be reviewed upon check-in on the day of the reservation.
 - Photographer(s) must wear a Photo Badge while on site. The badge will be provided upon check-in.
